San Luis de Sabinillas


Inspiring Casares

Casares Coast

A beautiful 2km stretch of coastline with golden beaches, Torre de la Sal watchtower, and beachfront spots. You can do lovely promenade walks to La Duquesa or to Estepona. Casares Coast also has a 'dog beach' which is fabulous for dog walks.



Bahía de Casares

An elevated area offering spectacular sea and mountain views. Home to Casares Golf and Finca Cortesin. Whilst elevated, the coast is a 15 minute walk away. Bahía de Casares is a great residencial area with a dog park, picnic areas, skate park and numerous cafés and restaurants.



Finca Cortesin & Doña Julia

Finca Cortesin, a world-renowned 5-star resort with Michelin dining, a beach club, bespoke luxury villas and exclusive gated urbanisations.

Doña Julia is a residencial area in Casares with a golf club and within a few minutes of the town of Sabinillas and Casares Costa.



Casares Village

A fairy-tale whitewashed village perched on a hillside with incredible views. Steep cobbled streets, a lively plaza, traditional ventas, and artisan spots like the Sierra Crestellina cheese factory make this a magical experience. A 20 minute drive from Casares Coast with fabulous restaurants dotted all the way up.

Cultural Estepona

A vibrant blend of old-town charm and stunning coastline



Estepona Old Town

A charming maze of whitewashed streets, colourful flowerpots, and striking murals that bring its walls to life. Its lively atmosphere invites you to explore hidden cafés, boutique shops, and beautiful corners at every turn. Plaza de las Flores sits at its heart, surrounded by cafés and orange trees.



Beachfront promenade

Lined with palm trees, fountains, gardens, and chiringuitos (beach bars), it's perfect for walking, cycling, or simply enjoying views of the Mediterranean, and North Africa. With children's play areas, shaded benches, and direct access to the marina and beaches.



Estepona Marina

A lively harbour with international restaurants, and a popular Sunday market. Walkable from the town centre via the seafront promenade, it's a top spot for both locals and tourists. There is a fabulous sky bar – a place to sip a drink whilst enjoying a spectacular, birdseye view over Estepona Coast.



West Estepona

Stretching towards Casares, this area boasts unspoilt beaches, golf courses like Valle Romano and Estepona Golf. It is a growing infrastructure, including a new hospital, school, and commercial areas. There is a mix of established urbanisations and new developments. Its proximity to Estepona Centre makes it a fabulous location to live in.
